This series looks at the impact from the institutional evolution of the wage system, social networks, and geographical factors on the determination of wages. After reviewing the history of China's wage policies and systematic transformation, the author examines the collective negotiation system as an example of institutional changes to explore the impacts on employees' wages, and does an empirical study on the shrinkage in labor's share of national income by using industrial and provincial data.

Based on the discussion of local policy-making decisions under fiscal federalism in China, the author also analyzes the regional wage differences with economic geographical and regional policy variances. China has a long cultural and educational tradition for over 5,000 years. Ancient schools began to take shape before the year 1100 BC. In the early twentieth century, the governments of the Qing Dynasty and the Republic of China established the classroom education system after reviewing similar systems in Japan and the United States. Before the founding of the People's Republic of China in 1949, 80% of the country's population was illiterate and the enrollment rate of primary school-age children was only 20%. With this in mind, Education in China seeks to present a

comprehensive overview of the Chinese educational system at all levels, from primary and secondary schools to vocational schools, colleges and universities, covering such important topics as educational legislation, administration, management, student admission and employment, continuing education, that took place in Chinese educational institutions over a span of 60 years (1949–2009).

The book examines how each educational system was adapted to meet the issues encountered, both domestic and foreign, at different stages of development. The author also describes how education is provided for the ethnic minorities and special groups, and one chapter is devoted to the nongovernmental education system. Topics such as the training and development of teachers, research in education, the use of information technology in all aspects of education, and international exchanges at each level of the education system are described toward the end of the book.

Sir Ernest Mason Satow (1843–1929) was a legendary British diplomat, a key figure in East Asia and Anglo-Japanese and -Chinese relations, particularly in Bakumatsu and Meiji Era Japan, and in China after the Boxer Rebellion. He also served in Siam (present-day Thailand), Uruguay, and Morocco, and represented Britain at the Second Hague Peace Conference in 1907. This transcribed and annotated collection, to be published in ten volumes, is based on Satow's original diaries and journals held in the UK National Archives, consisting of Satow's diaries and travel journals that cover a period of over sixtyfive years (1861 to 1926).

Volume 1 covers the period of 1861–1872, including the time he spent in China (January–August 1862) and Japan (September 1862–December 1872).

A legendary pioneer scholar of Asian studies, Alexander von Staël-Holstein (1877–1937) was a German-Baltic aristocrat and an émigré of Czarist Russia displaced by the Bolshevik Revolution. He took up an adjunct teaching position at Peking University and was subsequently a visiting professor at Harvard for the academic year 1928–29 and full professor of Central Asian Studies at Harvard from 1929 till his passing away. Throughout his career, Staël-Holstein repeatedly emphasized the importance of Sanskrit and Tibetan for the reconstruction of ancient Chinese phonetics. A significant portion of his works consists of translations and comparisons of Buddhist, Sanskrit, and Chinese Buddhist scriptures. The Academic Knight Between East and West is the first and

only comprehensive biography on Alexander von Staël-Holstein's life and academic achievements.

It is based on the transcripts of a series of 60 interviews with Zhang and his wife (Edith Chao 趙一荻) conducted by two Columbian scholars during 1991-1993. The transcripts and 145 audio cassettes of these interviews are now housed at the Peter H. L. and Edith C. Chang Reading Room in the Columbia University Library.

The current edition consists of seven volumes, including six volumes of transcripts carefully checked, edited, and annotated by Chinese scholars and one index and annotation volume. The Oral History not only recounts Zhang's personal life but also contains his comments on many historical events he personally experienced and influential figures he met.
