It must be a painful process to translate definitions exactly and find equivalents for words and expressions chosen by others, but that is power of the method. All the meanings and common expressions of words considered to be important by English compilers of an English dictionary have their equivalent in Vietnamese, or an explanation if there is no equivalent. It is precisely these idiomatic expressions and subtle variations of meaning that users of bilingual dictionaries usually wrack their brains to decipher.

Since the writers of the English expressions and the writers of the Vietnamese equivalents are each native speakers, the dictionary has none of the stilted quality of many bilingual dictionaries. One hopes that a good Vietnamese-Vietnames dictionary will be translated into a Vietnamese-English dictionary be native English speakers. Despite its higher price than other English-Vietnamese dictionaries, the "blue light" dictionary of the Linguistics Institute is recognized to be indispensible for serious users of both languages, both by Vietnamese and foreign researchers.]
