The present work amply illustrates just how rich this tradition is and will help to draw attention to a heritage that is rapidly disappearing. [The future of the Highlands in Central Vietnam is the subject of many discussions, often impassioned, especially with regard to the environment and the rights of the Indigenous Peoples. Successive waves if migrations, clearing and intensive development of land, and also modification processes of territorial rights, have caused these lands to change radically.

The metamorphoses they have undergone would make them seem foreign to early 20^{th}

century explorers who presented a picture of wild regions coloured with exotic fantasy, believing that they would find in this hinterland a " primitive" world far removed from the neighbouring civilizations. Recent works particularly show the predominant logic of State control, of commercialization and the integration of this Zone into world economy.
