[The present book is one of the pioneering studies not only on the reigning school of Mahayana Buddhism in Bhutan but also the cultural history of the country as a whole. It traces the diffusion and development of the Drukpa Kagyud school which became the state religion of Bhutan. In doing so, the work makes substantial contribution to the cultural, social and political histories of Bhutan. The work suggests that Tibet and Bhutan enjoyed intimate cultural relations in the pre-modern era but also encountered frequent political conflicts. This does not mean the Bhutanese and Tibetans share the same cultural identity. It is precisely for this reason that the Bhutanese fought five wars with Tibet mostly to defend their separate identity and territory.]
