[Bhutan possesses very rich biodiversity, and causes of this wealth are manifold. This thesis analyzes the role of public policy with regard to preservation of such rare biodiversity. Research on the country's public biodiversity policy is based on an approach that combines the Easton Systems Model with a process Model. The Analysis focuses on the program and implementation stages as well as relevant public policy actors and institutions. The program analysis covers the period 1959 to 1999. The strength of the public biodiversity policy in Bhutan lies in its long and incremental development. There are well functioning institutions in the country at the central and district levels as well as a strong culture of conservation. An extensive network of legally protected areas exists, with rich species, gene and ecosystem diversity.]
