Rongtse Ney, popularly known as 'Sangbay Ney' initially is located in Haa District under Gakyid Ling Gewog. It is believed to have been blessed and hidden into a sacred treasure site by Guru Rinpoche in the 8th century. Apart from Guru's Ney, the guide also features sacred sites of Khandro Yeshey Tshogyal, Dorji Phagmo, Phurpai Lhatshog, Baep Tsho and numerous other sacred sites. This book will be helpful particularly to the devotees who visit Guru's Ney which has five entrances presenting a multitude of amazing sacred treasures and holy depictions in the form of rocks.
