His English language works brought a much-needed Burmese perspective to the international study of Burmese history, hitherto written by British historians of the colonial era. Htin Aung authored many important books on Myanmar, under the pen name of Maung Htin Aung. His books are widely used in the study of the comparatively under-documented history and culture of Myanmar.
