He formed his own political party, the Tehrik-i-Istiqlal, in 1972 and continued to oppose dictatorial and autocratic rule through the difficult years of Ayub Khan, Zulfikar Ali Bhutto, and Ziaul Haq.

This book served to outline his efforts to propel Pakistan towards democracy, and completes the picture of his life in politics presented in his earlier work *We've Learnt Nothing from History*, published in 2005. He ends on a note of hope that Pakistan has a bright future and a warning that it is incumbent on all citizens to continue to work for peace and harmony, root out corruption, and differentiate between right and wrong.
